

TEST UPDATE

Gabapentinoid Confirmation Panel, QL, Urine Update

UVMHC

Effective September 23, 2024, Champlain Toxicology Lab will replace the quantitative test Gabapentinoid Confirmation Panel, Urine (LAB17260) with the new qualitative test Gabapentinoid Confirmation Panel, QL, Urine (LAB17697). The results will be reported out as “Positive” and “Negative” instead of numerical values. Any result greater than 500 ng/mL for gabapentin, and 250 ng/mL for pregabalin, will be reported out as “Positive”. Any result less than either of those cut-off values will display as “Negative”. There will be no change to the specimen requirements.
