

## TEST UPDATE

### Lupus Anticoagulant Reference Range & Test Ratio Cut-Off Updates

#### UVMMC

Effective 7/22/24, the Thrombosis and Hemostasis Laboratory at the University of Vermont Medical Center will implement new reagent lots for the Lupus Anticoagulant Cascade (Epic Code: LAB3629). This testing includes the dilute Russell viper venom time (dRVVT) and the Silica Clot time (SCT). With the new lots of reagents, the laboratory has established new normal reference ranges and Test Ratio (TR) cut-off values per the CLSI Guidelines (CLSI H60). Below is a summary of the changes:
