

## TEST UPDATE

### Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Testing Changes

#### UVMMC

On 6/25/2024, the UVMMC Laboratory will be changing the platform used for Chlamydia and Gonorrhea testing on urine, vaginal swabs, and cervical specimens from the Hologic Panther® to the **Roche cobas® 6800 system**. Method correlations were excellent between the two platforms.

#### Notable Changes:

- Endocervical and urethral swab specimens will no longer be accepted for CT and GC testing. These are not optimal collection sites.
- Anorectal and oropharyngeal (throat) swab specimens will continue to be tested on the Hologic Panther® platform. See below for collection instructions as they **differ** from that of the new platform.
- Acceptable specimens except cervical are to be collected in **cobas® PCR Media** (Roche Molecular Systems, Inc.). **Cervical specimens are to be collected in PreservCyt® Solution.**
- Orderable and resultable test names have been updated.


#### Specimen Collection Information:

Products containing carbomer(s), including vaginal lubricants, creams and gels may interfere with the test and should not be used during or prior to collecting urogenital specimens.

#### For vaginal and urine samples:

The cobas® PCR Media Uni Swab sample kits are used to collect and transport vaginal swab specimens. Urine should be transferred to the Urine PCR Media Tube. Given that collection of larger volumes of urine may reduce test sensitivity, please direct patients to provide first-catch urine (approximately 10 to 50 mL of the initial urine stream) into a urine collection cup.

#### For cervical samples:

Cervical specimens are to be collected in PreservCyt® Solution using a Thin Prep Vial.

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\*\*The cobas® Uni Swab and Urine PCR Media kits can be ordered beginning 6/10/2024 by contacting the UVMMC Laboratory Customer Service area at (802) 847-5121. **We will stop accepting the old collection media on 7/25/24.** This will allow providers time to transition to the new media and send the old media back to UVMMC.\*\*

#### For anorectal or oropharyngeal (throat) samples:

The Aptima Swab Collection Kit (Orange) should be used for anorectal or oropharyngeal samples as these **cannot be run on the new instrument.**

In addition, if the test **Vaginal CTGC and Vaginitis/Vaginosis Molecular Detection (LAB17610)** is ordered, please collect the vaginal swab specimen using the [Aptima transport vial](#) so only one swab needs to be submitted. The Vaginitis/Vaginosis testing is not available on the new cobas® 6800 system.
