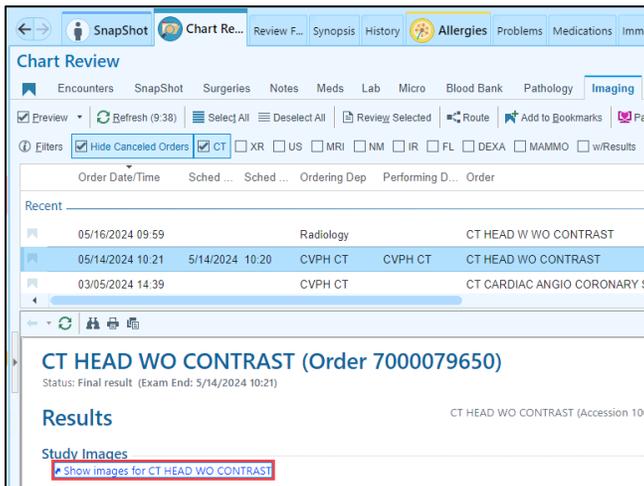


## View Diagnostic Images from Epic

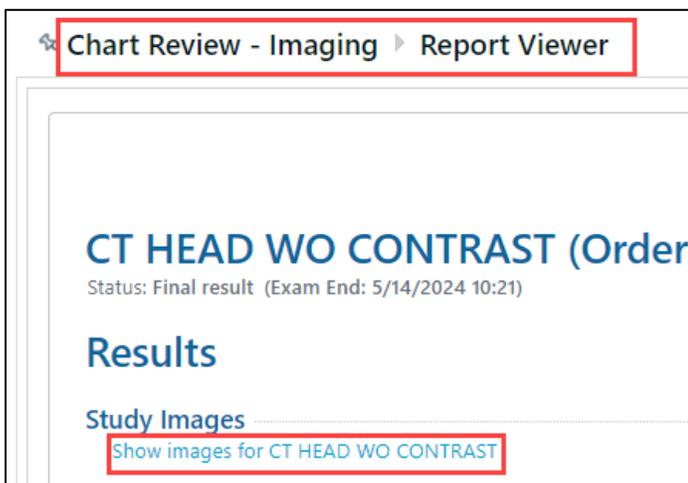
Diagnostic images from Radiology and Cardiology are viewble from Epic and EpicCare Link through an external application called eUnity. Diagnostic images will be available at time of image capture and prior to interpretation. There are several ways to access diagnostic images within Epic, EpicCare Link, or Epic’s Mobile applications. Outlined below are ways to access diagnostic images from the various areas of Epic.

### Access Images via Chart Review

- Open the Study Images report within Chart Review on the Imaging tab.
- Click on the hyperlink within the image report to launch eUnity to view the image.
  - eUnity will open in a new window which may take time, avoid clicking multiple times.



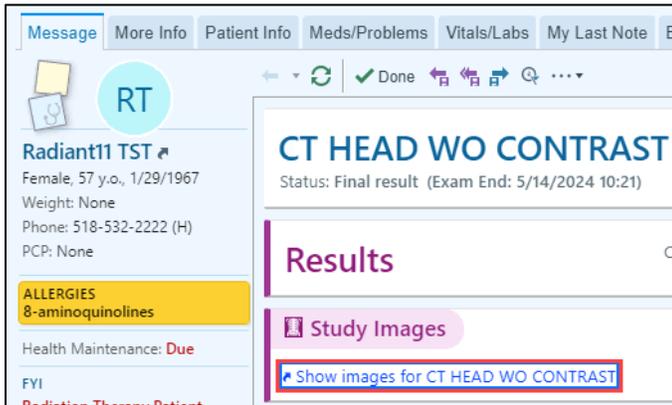

View in EpicCare Link

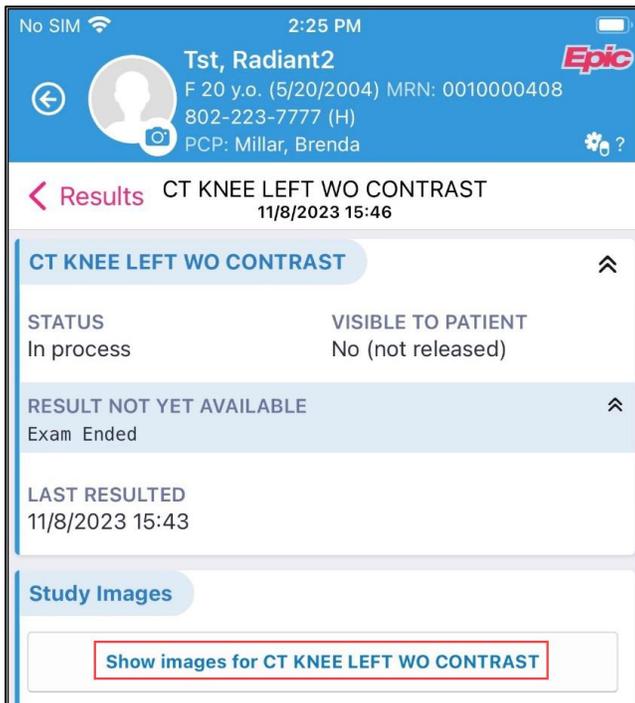
## Access Images via In Basket

- Open the Result message in the in basket.
- Click the link under Study Images to launch eUnity in a separate window to view images.



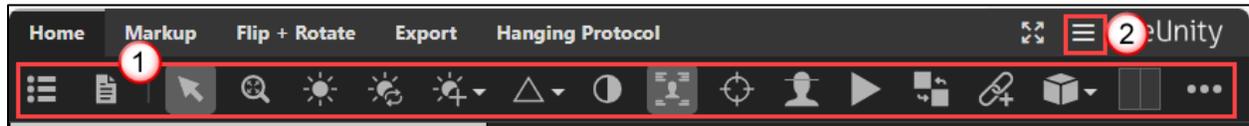
## Access Images via Epic Mobile Apps

- Within the Epic Mobile application, such as Haiku or Canto, images can also be viewed via a Results message in the in basket or by accessing the patient's chart via the schedule.
- Click **Show images** within the Study Images section of the report to access images in eUnity.
