

UVM Health TRANSIENT ISCHEMIC ATTACK (TIA) CLINIC REFERRAL/CONSULT

UVMH Neurology Department is offering a TIA Clinic for urgent referrals. All referrals must include the most recent visit note and imaging reports. Be sure imaging done outside UVMH is sent to UVMMC Film Library with reports.

TIA symptoms include unilateral weakness (face, arm, leg); change in speech; vision loss in one or both eyes; vertigo.

Referral criteria:

>TIA symptoms **WITHIN THE PAST 14 days:**

- Patient is CURRENTLY symptomatic -- direct to emergency medical services for further evaluation.
- Patient already evaluated for the TIA symptoms within the past 14 days and has had imaging -- URGENT referral to UVMMC Main Campus Neurology location only (for UVMMC TIA clinic). *Be sure imaging done outside UVMH is sent to UVMMC Film Library with reports.*
- Patient no longer symptomatic but symptoms < 14 days ago -- Direct to emergency medical services for further evaluation.

>TIA symptoms **MORE THAN 14 days ago:**

ROUTINE referral to UVMMC Main Campus Neurology location. *Be sure imaging done outside UVMH is sent to UVMMC Film Library with reports.*
