CPT Code Changes for Chlamydia/N. Gonorrhoeae Testing

UVM Health

Effective 1/1/26, the CPT codes for Chlamydia/N. Gonorrhoeae will be changing. Currently, we bill CPT code 87491 for Chlamydia trachomatis, amplified DNA and CPT code 87591 for Neisseria gonorrhoeae, amplified DNA. After the new year, the new CPT code **87494** will be billed. This new code encompasses **both** analytes. The pricing for these tests will remain unchanged.
