Effective 1/15/26, the new Mayo test, Lactoferrin, Feces (Mayo LCTF) will replace Lactoferrin, Fecal by ELISA (Mayo FLACF) and Lactoferrin, Quantitative, Stool (Mayo FLACQ), both of which will be obsolete.
