Residents may not offer, solicit or accept gifts or subsidies to or from vendors or others doing business with UVMHN - CVPH except as permitted by the UVMHN - CVPH vendor policies. Gifts or subsidies which violate applicable laws, or which are intended to induce the referral of patients to UVMHN - CVPH are strictly prohibited. Additional details regarding vendor relationships are found in the UVMHN- CVPH Administrative Policy entitled “Vendor Policy,” Policy #5.29.
