

# Test Update

## Test Name Change for BCR/ABL1 Qualitative Testing UVM Medical Center

Effective 6/15/26, UVMHC will be updating the test name for Mayo BCRFX, BCR/ABL1 Reflex, Qual/Quant to **BCR/ABL1 Initial Qualitative Diagnostic Assay w/Reflex to Quant (not for monitoring)**. The former name is confusing and may imply that the testing is for qualitative and/or quantitative testing when this order is intended as a diagnostic reflex panel ONLY. Once a specific transcript, such as p210 or p190 is identified, it is recommended to order the stand-alone quantitative assays for monitoring and/or follow-up.
